Show management reserves the right to settle and determine all questions, differences and disputes arising out of or connected with or incidental to this show within the boundaries of AMHR's current show rules.

Classes marked KSHA are point-earning classes for the Kansas Saddle Horse Association (KSHA) and are open to exhibitors and horses meeting the requirements for the class. These classes are Non-Rated classes under AMHR rules.

The Kansas Saddle Horse Association is an all-breed, family-oriented organization chartered in 1941 to promote good fellowship among all persons interested in horses in Kansas. Being a member is not required to show at our shows, but if you're a member of KSHA, showing at any KSHA-sponsored show can earn you and your horses points toward year-end awards! You can also earn KSHA points at other shows held in the state that are members of KSHA. Our year-end awards banquet is held each January to present the previous year's awards. All entries must be postmarked by JUNE 7, 2022 to qualify for Pre-Entry fees.

KSHA Office Fee: \$6.00/horse (weekend fee, pay once)

Stalls: \$55.00 (weekend fee, pay once) (maximum 2 horses per stall – Senior stallions must be stalled separately). Stalls available after 1:00 pm on Friday, June 17. **Early arrivals (prior to noon 6/17) or layovers (staying Sunday night) will be charged an additional \$20.00 per stall.** No showing from trailer. All horses must be stabled and shavings purchased from the facility.

Out-of-State Horses: Please bring horse's Health Certificate (within 30 days) and negative Coggin's test results (within 1 year) to present at check-in. Judges Evaluation Cards will be available in the Show Office, and may be completed on a voluntary basis. The show office will be open from 2:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m. on Friday, June 17 and 7:00 a.m. until one hour after the last class on Saturday.

All entry forms, copies of **both** sides of the AMHR registration papers if applicable, copies of Amateur or Youth cards if applicable, lease agreements, and a check/money order for payment of fees are to be sent when entering the show. Checks are to be made payable to: Heartland Miniature Horse Club. **Please note:** Horses having expired papers on file day of show **WILL NOT** be allowed in the show ring. **No back numbers will be given out until all bills are paid or there is a signed check on file in the show office.** **Non-payment of show fees is a violation of AMHR General Rule #133 and will be treated as such.** Checks returned for any reason will be charged a \$30 fee and must be replaced by cashier's check, cash or money order.

Youth Classes: All youth showing in AMHR Youth classes must have an AMHR Youth membership and provide a copy of their Youth card to participate. An application may be filled out with the Show Steward the day of show if needed. **AMHR youth are those youth 17 years & under as of January 1, 2022.**

Youth Scholarship: Interested Youth may fill out the attached Youth Scholarship application and submit with entries. The Heartland Miniature Horse Club Board of Directors will review the applications and select Youth(s) to receive a Scholarship to be used for one or more of the Youth classes they have entered.

Amateur Classes: A current AMHR Amateur Card is required to participate in AMHR Amateur classes and a copy must be provided to the show office. AMHR Members may purchase their Amateur card at the show for \$15.00. Applications will be available from the Show Steward.

Special Needs Exhibitors: Special needs exhibitors are welcome to show. We would appreciate advance notice if any special arrangements need to be made. Please contact the show manager.

Awards: Points and awards will be awarded by each judge. Ribbons will be awarded for 1st – 6th place, Grand Champions, Reserve Champions. Other awards may be available at show time.

Club High Point Awards: Only Heartland Miniature Horse Club members are eligible for this award and MUST be a current 2022 member PRIOR TO May 15, 2022. Each HMHC member/horse combination will be eligible, so a member can be eligible with more than one horse. This Award will be based on the AMHR point scale and all points earned by the member/horse combination at ALL Heartland Miniature Horse Club hosted shows will be counted. There will be awards to the High Point Halter Member/Horse combination, High Point Performance Member/Horse combination and High Point Youth Member/Horse combination. Recipients of the awards will be announced at the HMHC Annual Meeting. More information will be available at the show.

Measuring: Measuring will be from 5:00 – 7:00 p.m. on Friday, June 17 and from 7:00-8:00 a.m. and as needed on Saturday **All AMHR horses must be measured or show an Annual/Permanent Measurement card.** Exhibitor packets and back numbers will be issued **after** measurement. A clear copy of horse's current registration papers must be presented at measuring.

Tack Changes: Exhibitors needing extra time between classes must request a tack change at the gate before the start of the proceeding class.

Two Minute Gate: The gate is considered open when the first horse enters the ring for that class and will be closed in two minutes. No late exhibitors will be allowed into the ring after the gate closes. The two minute gate call will be strictly enforced. No refunds will be given for missed classes. It is the owner/handler/exhibitor's responsibility to be on time for classes.

Refunds: NO refund of stall or office fees. Refund of class entry fees will be given only for medical reasons and only after a certificate signed by a Doctor (human illness) or Veterinarian (horse illness) is received.

PA System: It is the owner/handler/exhibitor's responsibility to be on time for classes. Announcements to the barn area are a management courtesy.

Conduct: Cruelty, abuse or inhumane treatment of any horse in the show ring, barn, stalls or on the fairgrounds is strictly prohibited. The use of stimulants or depressants or any drug affecting the showing of a horse is forbidden.

Vendors: Vendor booth space is available the same days as stalling.

Concessions: The Kansas State Fair Facility Contracted Food Vendor may choose to not open during the show. If so, time will be allowed for exhibitors to visit the restaurant across the street.

Smoking: No smoking will be allowed in the barns, on deck, in the arena or in the horse show office.

Pets: All dogs should be leashed or contained at all times.

Non-Rated Class Descriptions

KSHA Baby Halter, 2 & Under – For Horses/Ponies/Miniatures 2 years old and under. To be judged by breed standard.

KSHA Reg Mini Horse Halter – Registration with AMHR or AMHA is required. Horses to be shown in hand at the walk and trot. Horses must also be viewed in motion from the side. In the case of two animals being judged equal, the higher placement shall be awarded to the smaller animal. In no case however, shall a smaller horse be placed over a larger horse with better conformation.

KSHA Prairie Pleasure Driving, Open – Open to western or hunter type horses, any size. Vehicle to be in safe and sound condition, 2- or 4-wheeled type, no reference is to be given in judging. Harness to light use harness or show harness in breast collar or full collar type. Flat walk, regular trot or optional gait and drive on. May be asked to back. Choice of attire is by discretion.

KSHA Reg Miniature Horse Driving – Registration with AMHR or AMHA is required. To be shown both ways of the arena at a Walk, Pleasure Trot, and an Extended Trot. Horses will enter the ring counter clockwise at a Pleasure Trot. Horses will be required to stand quietly and rein back.

KSHA In-Hand Trail – Required to work over or through obstacles. Open to all horses regardless of age or breed. To be shown at a walk and trot. No tack except a halter and lead allowed. A silver show halter shall not be counted above a good working halter.

KSHA Obstacle Driving – Horses/Ponies/Miniatures are required to work over and through obstacles. The course must accommodate suitable two (2) OR FOUR (4)-WHEEL VEHICLES. Horses in the obstacle driving class must not be asked to jump over any obstacles, but may be asked to drive over flat obstacles. Obstacles should simulate conditions normally encountered on a pleasant afternoon drive. This is not a timed event, and the speed with which the course is completed should not be used in whole or in part to determine placing.

KSHA Pleasure Driving, Open - any breed horse, 2- or 4-wheeled vehicles with light harness, bridle and blinkers, snaffle bit with overcheck or sidecheck. Shown with full mane and natural tail. Judged on performance, manners and suitability. Attendant in lineup permitted. Walk, normal trot, strong trot. Stand quietly and back readily.
